ENDOWMENTS IN A CHANGING ECONOMY BY DAWN RAINS As part of an overall financial strategy, National Arts Stabilization recommends that nonprofit arts organizations maintain an endowment equal to between 200% and 500% of annual operating expenses and look toward endowment investment earnings to generate between 10% and 25% of annual operating revenue
