As school based SLPs, many of us are required to write a professional goal for ourselves each year. In my district under the Danielson model, we call it an "Individual Growth Plan," while others may call it "Professional Development Goals," "Professional Goal Setting," "Professional Learning Plan," or something similar.

Setting Professional Goals as an SLP

Let's Talk Speech and Language: Student Learning ...

A Student Growth Objective, or SGO, is a long-term academic goal for groups of students set by teachers in consultation with their supervisors. An effective SGO must be: Specific and measurable. Aligned to New Jersey's curriculum standards. Based on available prior student learning data.

The Student Learning Goal/Objective in the teacher evaluation and support system is a carefully planned, broad academic goal that a teacher sets at the beginning of the year for all students or subgroups of students and is informed by available data. It is measured by Indicators of Academic Growth and Development (IAGDs), which include specific targets for student learning and expected ...
